


The main idea and supporting details of a sentence

Remember:

The main idea is what the sentence is about or the topic of the sentence

An orange is delicious and healthy.

- 1. What is the main idea of this sentence?
- 2. What are the supporting details of the sentence?




The main idea of the sentence is ORANGE.


(The sentence talks about orange)

And, the supporting details are 'delicious' and 'healthy'

 (Delicious and healthy gives explanation about the orange)

An orange is delicious and healthy.





Playing basketball is fun but tiring.

What is the main idea of the sentence? (What is the sentence about?) What are the **supporting details** of the sentence? (What details give explanation to the main idea?)



Playing basketball is fun but tiring.

- The main idea of the sentence is playing basketball. (The sentence is about playing basketball).
- The supporting details that give explanation about the main idea are: **fun** and **tiring**.



- MAIN IDEA is the most important idea that the author wants the reader to remember or what the text is about.
- SUPPORTING DETAILS are the points that support (describe and explain) the main idea

Main idea and supporting details of a paragraph

Sample Paragraph

- What is the main idea?
- What are the supporting details.

Yesterday, I bought a new coat The new coat is <u>bright red</u>. It has six buttons. The coat is <u>very thick</u> so I can stay form during cold weather.
